Garbage and Recyclables

Garbage pick-up is every Friday and recyclables are picked up every other Friday. Only

exception is some holiday weeks. The village clerk can provide you with the yearly calendar of pick up dates. If you do not have a calendar, please ask for one. Containers are provided by the village. If your container gets damaged, please contact the village office at 920-477-4304. Containers on the day of pick up must be placed at the end of your driveway and made assessable for the garbage truck to pick up by 6:00 AM. Please leave at least 3 feet between garbage and recycling container

Snow Removal

From November 1st to April 1st, There is <u>NO Overnight Parking</u> on village streets. Sidewalks must be cleared by noon the following day of snowfall. Please make sure sidewalks are kept clear of snow, ice and debris. <u>Do Not Blow or Shovel</u> snow back into a cleared street.

Grass Clippings and Yard Waste

Do not blow grass clippings into the street. There is a dumpster located at the Village Park for grass clippings and yard waste.

Contact Ed Costello at 920-979-3444 to make arrangement or for instructions of where to dispose of brush. Do not put brush in yard waste dumpster. Small pieces of brush can be put in the trailer located beside the dumpster. Large amounts of brush, please contact Ed.

Bulky Waste

Please refer to the village website <u>www.villageofeden.com</u> or the newsletter in the quarterly sewer bills for the date, time , and location for the annual bulky waste drop-off. There is a nominal charge for this service which will be indicated in the notice.



Property Taxes

Property taxes bills are mailed out on the 15th of December of each year.

Payment in full or 1st installment is due by January 31st to the Village of Eden office located in the Eden Community Center –104 Pine Street , (PO Box 65). Collection dates and times will be included in your tax bill. After January 31st, all payments are collected at the Fond Du Lac County Treasures Office (County Government Office) 160 S. Macy Street in Fond Du Lac. 2nd installment is due by July 31st and payment to Fond Du Lac County.

Storage of Recreational Vehicles

No trailers, recreation vehicles, mobile homes, camping trailers and/or boats shall be stored or left standing on any street or highway for more than twenty-four (24) hours

Dog Licenses

A license will need to be obtained at the Eden Village Office –104 Pine Street Dogs must be licensed on or before 5 months of age. A current copy of the animals rabies certificate must be presented at the time the license is applied for. Payment needs to be made before license can be issued.
