Colin Salter from the Ejaa has been in contact with Van Guard Renewables to see if they will help donate to cover some of those remaining costs. They will let him know. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Lee Fowler and seconded by Owen Gellings to purchase garbage cans will lids to be placed around the community park. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Marian Blakely and seconded by Joe Preston to set the donation amount to receive a plaque at the park to \$500.00. Motion carried.

There was a discussion on the gazebo that was wanted in the park. The current board is unclear of what the original vision for the gazebo was. They are going to investigate this further.

There was a discussion on purchasing Cameras or Motion sensors at the park by the bathrooms for a little more security and deterrent of vandalism. The board will evaluate options and pricing.

There was a discussion on parking at the community park for athletic events. A suggestion was made to put a ramp over a portion of the curb and designate parking in the grass.

The board is looking into fixing the boardwalk in the park as it is needing repair. There are areas that need to have boards replaced and it needs to be leveled out.

Cindy Koffman voiced her concerns about making the park more handicapped accessible.
