1. CALL OF MEETING TO ORDER

A discussion was had about the Lakeside foods project. They are planning on an addition to their existing facility at 108 Main Street. The existing facility produces canned pet food and the predominate purpose of the new expansion is to house additional canning cookers for their pet food line. A new boiler will also be provided to supply steam for the cookers. The proposed site improvements include replacement of the pavement areas and new building addition over the existing pavement and canopied area. All the disturbance occurs over existing impervious area that drains west toward the facility and will be collected with storm sewer. There are no changes to the stormwater runoff. J.E Arthur looked over the plans for the Village and it is in their opinion that the site plan may be approved and full permitting for the project may be issued. The planning commission agreed with them.
