

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
THE DISCHARGING AND CARRYING
OF FIREARMS AND GUNS

The Village Board of the Village of Eden, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

No person, except a sheriff, constable, police officer, or their deputies, shall fire or discharge any firearm, rifle, spring or air gun of any description within the Village of Eden, or have any firearm, spring or air gun in his possession or under his control unless it is unloaded and knocked down or enclosed within a carrying case or other suitable container, provided that this section shall not prevent the maintenance and use of a duly supervised rifle or pistol range or shooting gallery as may be authorized by the Village Board. This subsection shall be deemed to prohibit hunting within the Village, provided that the Village Board may issue written permission to owners or occupants of private premises to hunt or shoot on such premises if it finds that such privileges are necessary for the protection of life or property and subject to such safeguards as the Village Board may impose for the safety of the lives and property of other persons within the Village limits.

Section 2.


Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon adjudication thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$ 5⁰⁰, nor more than \$ 50⁰⁰, and the costs of prosecution, and upon default in the payment of any forfeiture and costs, may be imprisoned in the County Jail of Fond du Lac County

until such forfeiture and costs are paid but not to exceed five (5) days.


Section 3.
